CERT members are groups of active residents that have received special training for the purpose of enhancing their ability to recognize, respond to, and recover from a major emergency affecting the Rockwall community. Learn how you can help yourself, your family, and your community during a disaster.

CERT members learn basic emergency skills, such as first aid, CPR, triage, fire suppression, utilities management, communications, and traffic/crowd control. People trained in the CERT program will be able to immediately take care of themselves, assist others, and help those in distress before, during, and after a major emergency or disaster situation. CERT members can provide vital services in the absence of emergency responders whose arrival may be delayed.

Course Information

The Nationally Certified FEMA Course is used to teach Rockwall CERT members how to perform essential life-saving functions while awaiting the arrival of professional emergency responders.

Program: Two consecutive Saturdays in the fall for a total of 16 hours.
