STREET PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS

SEPTEMBER 8, 2011

The City of Rockwall has contracted with APAC-Texas Inc. to make street repairs to Margaret Street between Austin Street and N. Fannin Street. The repairs will be made in two phases. The first phase of the improvements will include removing the old asphalt and re-stabilizing the street base. The second phase will be to place new asphalt on the roadway.

Weather permitting; the first phase will be conducted between Friday September 16, 2011 and Monday September 19, 2011. It is our intent to leave the street open to residential traffic as much as possible during this process; however you may experience temporary delays. In order minimize your inconvenience; the work will not start until after 8:30 a.m.

The second phase of the street improvement is scheduled for Tuesday, September 20, 2011 and should be completed the same day, weather permitting. The road will remain open to residential traffic during the asphalt laying process; however there may be some temporary delays. The start of the asphalt work will be postponed until after 8:30 a.m. so as to not interfere with your morning travel schedules.

The City will coordinate with Allied Waste and normal schedules for garbage pick up will be maintained.
