STREET PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS

SEPTEMBER 8, 2011

The City of Rockwall has contracted with APAC-Texas Inc. to make street repairs to a section of Lofland Circle. The section of Lofland Circle to be repaired is a section of asphalt pavement beginning at S.H. 205 (S. Goliad) proceeding to the west a distance of approximately 2,225ft. The repairs will be made in two phases. The first phase of the improvements will consist of removing the old asphalt and re-stabilizing the street base. The second phase will be to place new asphalt on the roadway.

Weather permitting; the first phase will be completed on Monday September 12, 2011 or Tuesday September 13, 2011. It is our intent to leave the street open to traffic as much as possible during this process; however you may experience temporary delays. In order minimize your inconvenience; the work will not start until after 8:30 a.m.

The second phase of the street improvements is scheduled for Thursday, September 15, 2011 or Friday September 16, weather permitting. The road will remain open to traffic during the asphalt laying process; however there may be some temporary delays. The start of the asphalt work will be postponed until after 8:30 a.m. so as to not interfere with your morning travel schedules.
