City of Rockwall Council Candidate Forum

ROCKWALL, TEXAS – April 5, 2018 – A forum for candidates running for Rockwall City Council will be held on Wednesday, April 11, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. The event will take place at Rockwall City Hall, located at 385 S. Goliad Street. Judge Brian Williams will serve as the moderator of the candidate forum, which is open to the public. The event will be broadcast live, and can be accessed at rockwall.com.

The General Election will be held on Saturday, May 5, 2018 for the purpose of electing three City Councilmembers - one each for Places 2, 4 and 6. Terms for Rockwall City Councilmembers are for a period of two years.
