

Annual Backflow Test

Backflow Prevention Assembly Testers (BPAT) must register with the City of Rockwall, accompanied with a certification of the test gauge used, calibrated within the last 12 months. Registration and fees are collected through the Building Inspections Department at 385 South Goliad.

Annual inspections shall be made of all backflow prevention assemblies and air gaps to determine if they are operable. An individual that has a current BPAT license through the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) shall perform tests. Test results shall be recorded on the City of Rockwall Backflow Prevention Assembly Test Form, and submitted to the City of Rockwall Water Department at 1600 Airport Road, 75087.

Steps for registering as a BPAT in the City of Rockwall
Registration location - 385 South Goliad, Rockwall, Texas

- Complete registration form
- Copy of TCEQ BPAT license
- Copy of driver's license
- Copy of gauge serial number and calibration certificate
- Fee of \$100.00

Renewal with the City is required when BPAT licenses are renewed with the TCEQ.
