VIII. Conclusions

The development would not adversely affect the floodplain or floodway for either effective FIS conditions or fully projected conditions. OEI believes the results of the analyses show that the FEMA requirements of 44CFR, Section 60.3(d) have been met. Further, that the results in this analysis allow for geometry and minimum floor elevations that will result in a development that is reasonably safe from flooding per the definition included in 44CFR, Section 65.2(c).

A large number of proposed lots along the eastern side of the development are within the effective FIS floodplain. To meet City and FEMA requirements, a Letter of Map Revision will have to be requested from FEMA to revise the effective floodplain mapping. This request will be developed and submitted for City approval and submittal to FEMA upon completion of construction. Design of the subdivision should be based on the results of the fully projected post construction models included in this study.
