	3. A description of the proposed log or lots and the boundaries thereof, as proposed setbacks on the lots.
	4. With the exception of single family dwellings, the location of each existing and each proposed structure in the development, the use or uses to be contained therein, the number of stories, the gross floor area, and the location of entrances and loading poir thereof. If a particular type structuis to be built a number of times, a typical lot layout may be substituted.
	5. All public rights-of-way, curb cuts, driving lanes, parking areas, loading areas, public transportation areas, and illumination facilities for the same, including existing facilitie to be relocated. Design criteria for illumination facilities may be require
