

		2. In addition to data and drawings prescribed, the application shall be accompanied by a tabulation of the area proposed to be devoted to each land use and a tabulation of the averapopulation density per net acre and per gross acre in the area or areas proposed to be devoted to residential use
		3. A description of the proposed lot or lots and the boundaries thereof, ar proposed setbacks on the lots.

With the exception of single family dwellings, the location of each existing and each proposed structure in the development, the use or uses to be contained therein, the number of stories, the gross floor area, and the location of entrances and loading poir thereof. by the applicant's architect, planner, landscape architect, engineer and/or land surveyor if these services are required. In addition to an engineer and a planner, the applicant's submittal may be required to contain the professional services of at least two of the remaining three professionals involved in the design and construction of the environment.
