
CITY OF ROCKWALL OFFICIAL RECEIPT

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### DESCRIPTION

BEING, two tracts or parcels of land situated in Rockwall County, Texas, being part of the R. Ballard Survey, Abstract No. 29, being part of the 11 1/3 acre tract described in a deed from W.F.
