


LAKESIDE CHURCH OF CHRIST Conceptual Land Use Plan Feb. 1990

Background Information:

Last year the Council approved a CUP for buildings with less than 90% masonry for the Lakeside Church of Christ located on SH-66. They wanted to use 5 portable buildings for two years in order to raise the funds necessary to build their permanent structures. They would like to obtain approval to add one additional building to serve as an administration building. They would also like to extend the time period for the use of the portable buildings for one additional year. The current permit approves them only until November 1991. Our attorney has indicated that the Council may consider this request without reopening the CUP. Attached you will find a revised site plan and a letter from the Church.



Dear Ms. Couch,

The Lakeside Church of Christ desires to make application to amend our existing conditional use permit to allow the use of one additional temporary structure on our property located at 950 Williams Street. This proposed building is 14' x 66' and would be located as shown on the plan.

The new building will provide much-needed administration area for our growing staff, as well as additional classroom space. Due to our continued rapid growth, we have outgrown our facilities before long range planning and financial strength can be in place. We want to have a quality and well planned facility for the future, and believe that this additional temporary building will help us meet that goal.

As you know, our current conditional use permit, which expires in one year, involves temporary parking as well as temporary buildings. Our intent is to have permanent parking installed as well as a master land use plan in place at the time our current permit expires. Due to the expense of a recently completed building that complies with the city requirements, and the expected expense of the parking area, we request an amendment to the permit to allow use of the new temporary building as well as our existing temporary buildings for a period of two years from this date.

Background Information:

In February 1990 the Commission and City Council approved the use of a gravel parking lot and the use of portable buildings for the Lakeside Church of Christ, located on SH-66 west of the Middle School. The original request was to expire in November 1991. In November 1991 the Church asked for a one year extension and one additional building. This was granted. The Church has now completed a fund raising drive and they plan to begin construction of a new facility in January. They have requested an extension to permit them to complete their construction program. Attached is a letter from Mike Perry outlining their request.

The Lakeside Church of Christ now owns clear title to the property at 950 Williams Street. As I discussed with you last week, we had a very successful fund-raising effort on Oct. 25, enabling us to buy the land and begin work on a new facility and parking.

The committee which is now working on plans and specifications is to have their part of the project done in January. Construction is expected soon thereafter, as city approval is given and a contractor is chosen.
