



OWNER'S CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS, TED CAIN, BEING THE OWNER OF A TRACT OF LAND situated in the B.F. Boydstun Survey, Abstract Number 14, in the City of Rockwall, Rockwall County, Texas and being all of Cain Properties No. 1, an addition to the City of Rockwall according to the plat recorded in Slide B, Page 7 of the Plat Records of Rockwall County, Texas (PRRCT) and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a 5/8 inch iron rod set for the northeast corner of said Cain Properties No. 1 and being located in the westerly right-of-way line of Goliad Street (State Highway 205) (a 100 feet wide right-of-way);

THENCE along the northerly line of said Cain Properties No. 1 DUE EAST a distance of 188.33 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING;

CONTAINING within these metes and bounds 4.159 acres or 181,186 square feet of land, more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT Ted Cain being the owner, does hereby adopt this plat designating the hereinabove described property as REPLAT OF CAIN PROPERTIES NO. 1, an addition to the City of Rockwall, Rockwall County, Texas, and does hereby dedicate to the public use forever the streets and alleys shown thereon, and does hereby reserve the easement strips shown on this plat for the purposes stated and for the mutual use and accommodation of all utilities desiring to use or using same. No buildings shall be constructed or placed upon, over or across the utility easements as described herein. Any public utility shall have the right to remove and keep removed all or part of any buildings, fences, trees, shrubs, or other growths or improvements which in any way endanger or interfere with construction, maintenance or efficiency of their respective system on any of these easement strips; and any public utility shall at all times have the right of ingress and egress to, from and upon the said easement strips for purpose of construction, reconstruction, inspecting, patrolling, maintaining, and either adding to or removing all or part of their respective system without the necessity of, at any time, procuring the permission of anyone. The City of Rockwall will not be responsible for any claims of any nature resulting from or occasioned by the establishment of grade of streets in the subdivision. The developer and subdivision engineer shall bear total responsibility for storm drainage improvements. The developer shall be responsible for the necessary facilities to provide drainage patterns and drainage controls such that properties within the drainage area are not adversely, by storm drainage from the development.

No house dwelling unit, or other structure shall be constructed on any lot in this addition by the owner or any other person until such time as the developer has compiled with all requirements of the Subdivision Regulations of the City of Rockwall regarding improvements with respect to the entire block on the street or streets on which property abuts, including the actual installation of streets with the required base and paving, curb and gutter, water and sewer, drainage structures, storm sewers, and alleys, all according to the specifications of the City of Rockwall.

It shall be the policy of the City of Rockwall to withhold issuing building permits until all street, water, sewer and storm drainage systems have been accepted by the City. The approval of a plat by the City does not constitute any representation, assurance or guarantee that any building within such plat shall be approved, authorized or permit therefore issued, nor shall such approval constitute any representation, assurance or guarantee by the City of the adequacy and availability for water for personal use and fire protection within such plat, as required under Ordinance 83-54.
