## **HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE:**

The home was purchase by J.F. Corry (1867-1955) in 1898. It is believed to have been built around 1850. It later became the Garner Family home. Mrs. Pearl Garner, who was known for her cooking, operated a boarding house at this location.

Archeologists believe that this site was an Indian burial ground.

The home was remodeled by the Pittmans in 1990.
