## **HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE:**

The cottage was built in 1885 by M. H. McCoy, a banker and businessman who also owned Rockwall's first hardware store and later became a prominent banker. The home was purchased in 1977 by Jim and Pat Buttgen. The Gazebo in the back yard served as the site for the weddings of the Buttgens' two (2) daughters.

During the 1970's, the Buttgens discovered the remains of a unique underground watering mechanism invented by Mr. McCoy as well as some promotional plates that suggested that he was involved in the manufacture of buggies.
